To learn about the difference between a secret and a surprise.



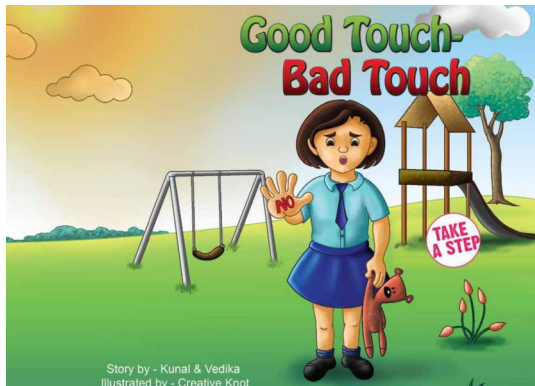
To demonstrate how to listen to other people and to understand how to play cooperatively.

Key Vocabulary

Secret	Hidden from the knowledge of others
Surprise	To cause to feel wonder or amazement because of being unexpected
Cooperatively	Willing to be helpful by doing what someone wants or asks for.
Support	Helping or giving advice to others
Feedback	Helpful information or criticism given to someone to indicate what can be done to improve something.
Appropriate	Appropriate is defined as something that is right for the purpose.
Inappropriate	Not right or proper.
Teasing	A person who makes fun of people usually in a friendly way.
Bullying	One who is repeatedly cruel, insulting, or threatening to others who are weaker, smaller, or in some way vulnerable.
Unacceptable	Not pleasing or welcome.
