Key Learning

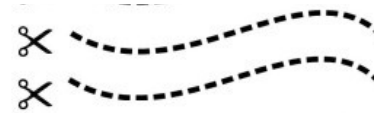
I can explore different decorations and look closely at their materials and their designs.



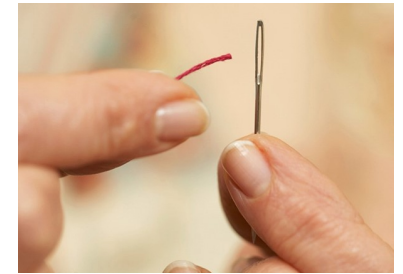
I can compare and contrast Christmas baubles looking at their colours, designs and materials.

Key Vocabulary

Sewing/Stitch	To join 2 pieces of material together using a needle and thread.
Overstitch	The thread is sewn over the 2 edges of material to join them together.
Running stitch	The thread is sewn in and out of the 2 pieces of material to join them together.
Needle	A slender tool with a point at one end and an eye for thread.
Fabric	Materials used to make the decorations.
Design	To plan and draw an idea using research and product knowledge.
Create	To make their Christmas decoration using the skills they have learnt.
Evaluate	To look at their creation and think about the things that have worked well and those that they would change to improve next time.
