# Key Vocabulary

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| Allah    | The Muslim name for God.  |
| Minaret  | A slender tower, typically part of a mosque, with a balcony from which a Muezzin calls Muslims to prayer .  |
| Mosque   | The Muslim place of worship.  |
| Muhammed | The founder of Islam.   |
| Muslim   | Someone who follows the faith of Islam.   |
| Prophet  | Someone who declares publicly a message that he or she believes has come from God.  |
| Qur'an   | The Holy book of Islam.   |
| Sacred   | Dedicated or devoted to the service of God .  |
| Shahadah | The Shahadah is the Muslim declaration of faith and the first Pillar of Islam . It expresses the belief that there is no god but Allah and that Muhammad is the messenger of Allah. |
| Wudu     | The ritual washing performed by Muslims before prayer.  |
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
