To learn about the skills necessary to contribute to the life in the classroom.



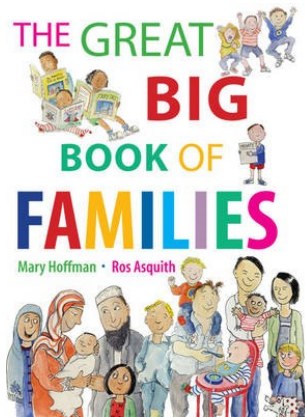
To learn how group and class rules can help us. To give reasons for the rules that have been agreed in their class.
