Key Learning

To be able to explain what is meant by anti-social behaviour and give example of what these behaviours might be.



To know what to do if they experience these anti-social behaviours and explain potential consequences of anti-social behaviour.



To understand that bullying is not the victims fault and that no one should give in to being bullied.



To understand that the media can influence our choices and decisions. To know that we need to be cautious of things that we read or hear in the media.



To be able to describe simple ways we can take care of the environment and give reasons for why it is important to care for the local environment.



Key Vocabulary

Consequences	Something that happens as a result of someone behaving in a particular way. Consequences can be positive or negative.
Anti-social behaviour	Behaviour by a person which causes, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to another person.
Bullying	One who is repeatedly cruel, insulting, or threatening to others who are weaker, smaller, or in some way vulnerable.
Victim	Someone who is hurt, injured, or killed by a person, group, or event.
Media	There are many different ways that information can be passed to many people in a society. These include television and radio broadcasts and articles in newspapers. These methods of communication are known as media. In recent years, the Internet has become an increasingly important part of media.
Influences	To affect or change in an indirect but usually important way.
Local	The area where you live.
