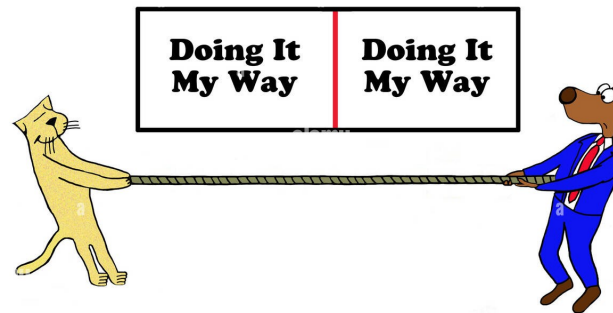
## Key Learning

To be able to give examples of causes of disputes and conflicts.

To describe and demonstrate strategies to use for negotiation and appropriate compromise.



To understand what bullying is, what being bullied may feel like and to understand that in our school bullying will not be tolerated.



To be able to give examples of different types of relationships. To be able to describe family members and their relationship to the rest of the family.



To be able to explain who is important to them and why. To be able to describe ways in which relationships are made particularly special and important e.g. marriage.



# Key Vocabulary

Disputes	To argue or debate about.
Conflict	A conflict is a struggle between people which may be physical, or between differing ideas.
Negotiation	To bargain or come to an agreement with another person.
Compromise	To settle a dispute by agreeing that each side will change or give up some demands.
Relationships	The way in which two or more people, talk to, behave towards and deal with each other.
Bullying	One who is repeatedly cruel, insulting, or threatening to others who are weaker, smaller, or in some way vulnerable.
