Year 3—Why do people pray?

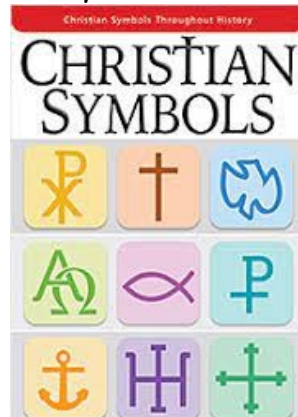

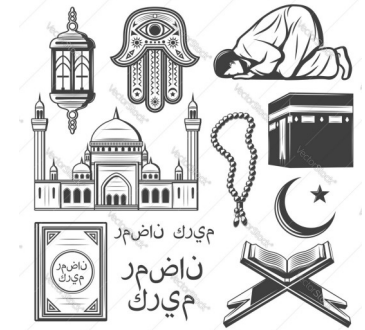

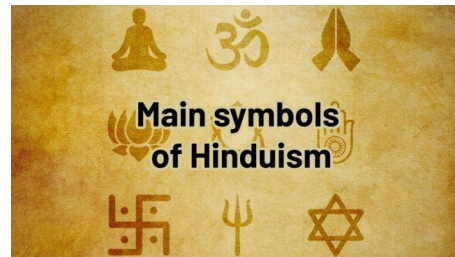
