Key Vocabulary

Health	The condition of being free from illness or disease.
Well being	The state of being healthy, safe, comfortable and happy.
Environment	All the physical surroundings on Earth are called the environment.
Traditions	The handing down of information, beliefs, or customs from one generation to another.
Cultures	Culture is a word for the 'way of life' of groups of people, meaning the way they do things.
Respect	Caring enough to consider how words and actions impact others.
Tolerance	When you accept others who are different in their race, culture, habits, and even beliefs.
Resources	Something that can be used for a purpose. For example, tools and materials are resources.
Allocated	To divide and give out for a special reason or to particular people or things.
Community	A group of people living or working together in the same area.
