



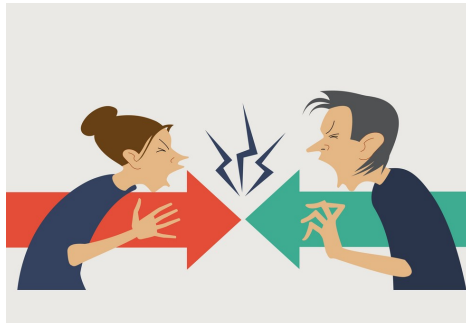
Mossfield Primary School Knowledge Organiser

To understand that there is no bullying at a KIVA school.

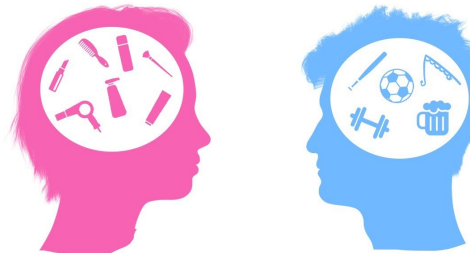


To learn about differences and similarities between people.

WHAT IS STEREOTYPE



Key Vocabulary

Dispute	To argue or debate about.
Conflict	A struggle of conflicting ideas between people. Conflicts arise because there are needs, values or ideas that are seen to be different.
Negotiation	To bargain or come to an agreement with another person.
Compromise	To settle by agreeing that each side will change or give up some demands.
Differences	What makes two or more persons or things not the same.
Similarities	The state or quality of being similar; resemblance
Stereotyping	A fixed idea that many people have about a thing or a group that may often be untrue or only partly true.
