Year 5 — What would Jesus do? Can we live by the values of Jesus in the twenty-first century?

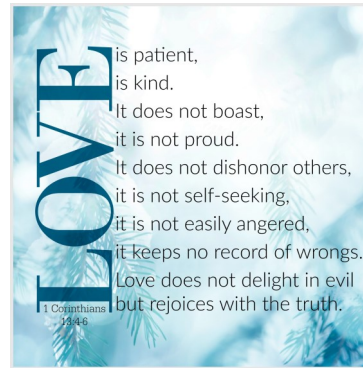

Key Vocabulary

Anointed	To anoint is to apply perfumed oil. It was a common practice among the Hebrews. The act of anointing was used to prepare someone for a sacred role or mission.
Charity	An organization set up to provide help and raise money for those in need.
Corinthians	A book in the Bible.
Fairness	Impartial and just treatment or behaviour without favouritism or discrimination.
Forgiveness	Letting go of feelings of resentment and vengeance. You're refocusing your thoughts on positive emotions; perhaps even feelings of understanding, empathy, and compassion toward the person who hurt you.
Parable	A Parable is a story with a moral lesson or instruction, particularly those told by Jesus in the Bible.
Persecute	Persecution is the mistreatment (bad treatment) of an individual or group by another group.
Widow	A woman who has lost her spouse by death and has not remarried.
