To learn that different cultures can have different practises and traditions and that these may be illegal and against a person's human right.



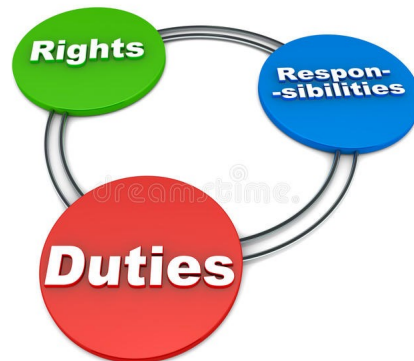
To know what to do if they get bullied.
