



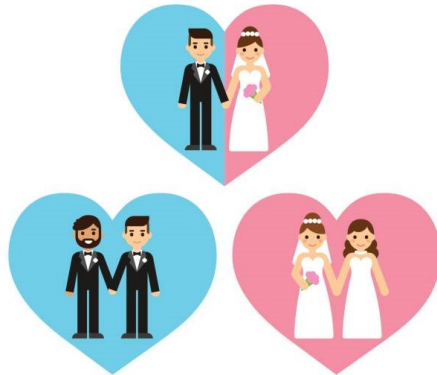
# Mossfield Primary School Knowledge Organiser



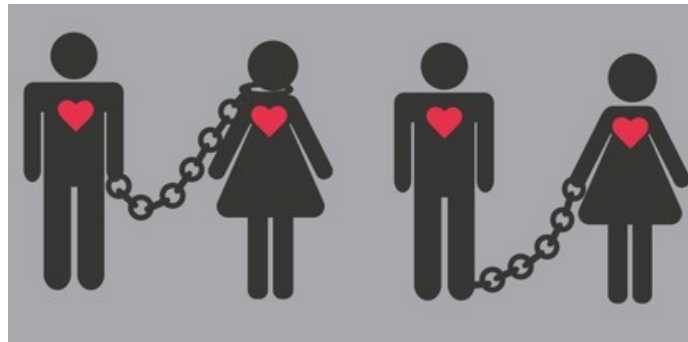
Year 6— **Relationships** — This unit supports pupils to develop healthy relationships in various contexts, and to know when to seek help. Through each unit the children also complete lessons from the KIVA (anti-bullying programme) and lessons from the No Outsiders in Our School programme which teaches children about the characteristics protected by the Equality Act.

## Key Learning

To understand that marriage, arranged marriage and civil partnership is between two people who willingly agree.



To know that forced marriage is against the law. To know what to do if they or someone they know is under threat of forced marriage.



To learn about the consequences of bullying.



To learn about managing and maintaining relationships and improving communication and negotiation.



To understand how to respond to discrimination.



To be able to share ideas for positive steps that can be taken to support people who have suffered discrimination, bullying or aggressive behaviours.



# Key Vocabulary

Forced marriage	Forced Marriage is an abuse of human rights and, where a child is involved, an abuse of the rights of the child.
Communication	Communication is the act of giving, receiving, and sharing information .
Negotiation	Each individual or group of people is given the same resources or opportunities.
Discrimination	Discrimination is when a person is treated differently (not in a good way) because of some aspect of their identity.
