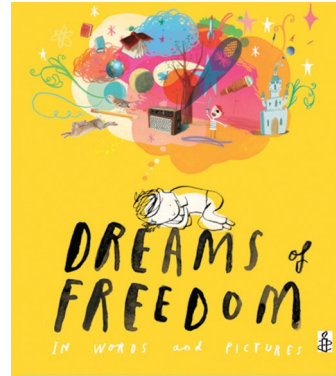

To recognise their freedom through studying the text 'Dreams of Freedom.'



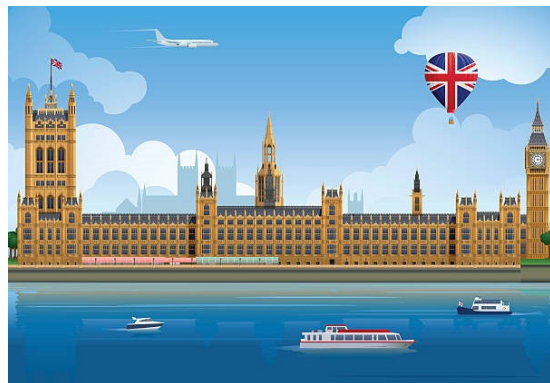
To know how to research and make recommendations on topical issues.
