Year 6 – Christianity and Humanism

Learn in depth from Christianity and from Humanism, a non-religious way of life.

Key Learning

To explore the concepts of being naughty and being good in terms of actions, words and thoughts.



To understand that not all people are religious, that non-religious people can have codes for living that don't refer to god, and that a person can be 'good without god'.



To think carefully about the Christian ideas of values such as love and forgiveness.



To clarify the values that matter most to pupils, and explore how different people have different values.



To understand more deeply that peace is valued by both Humanists and Christians, but it is not always easy to build.



To draw learning about values together and express ideas of our own about how values can make a community happier.
